Definition of an Authorised Visitor

An authorised visitor is a person who presents at an affiliated ABA club, Branch, State or National shoot, but not participating in any archery activities.

An authorised visitor may be, but not limited to a friend, relative, carer (see Carer's Policy), partner of a current ABA member, or a potential new member seeking information on the club/association.

All authorised visitors must sign in and out as a visitor.

Authorised visitors cannot participate in any archery activities i.e. shoot a bow and arrow, knife & axe throwing or novelty events, may not hold Club Office and may not exercise a vote in decisions of the Club.

A Probationary member is considered an authorised visitor at club level only, but can shoot a bow and arrow under supervision. See definition of a probationary member. A probationary member may not hold club office and may not exercise a vote in the decisions of the club.

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
